The next session for agility will not start until mid to late January.

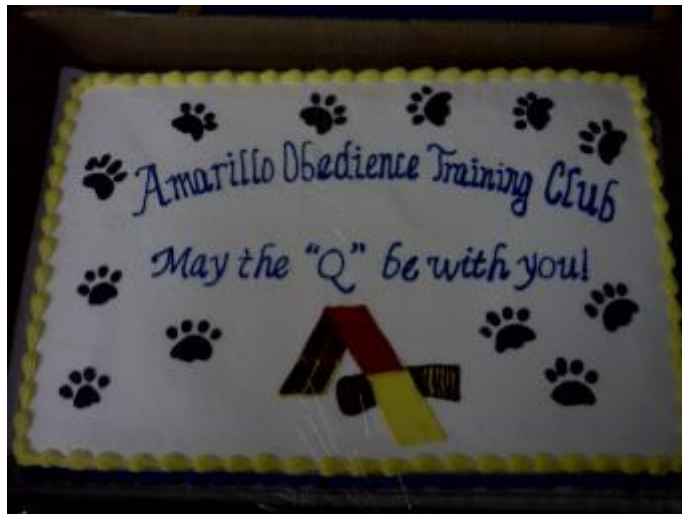
